CHILDREN'S ART & SHORT STORY CONTESTS

The Friends of the Cerritos Library will conduct the 15th Annual Art Contest for children in grades K-6 and a Short Story Contest for children in grades 3-6. "My Very Own Theme Park" is the theme for the art contest and "A Surprise Package in the Mail" is the theme for the short story contest. Participants must have a valid Cerritos Library card. The deadline to turn in all entries is Friday, October 20 before 9 p.m.

Design a picture about your very own theme park. Art work must be no larger than 12" x 18" and unmounted. Only one art entry is allowed per child.

Short Stories about a "Surprise Package in the Mail" must be original, using no more than 500 words and preferably typed on white letter-sized paper. Only one short story entry is allowed per child.

COMPUTER RESERVATION SYSTEM IMPLEMENTED

The Cerritos Library now offers a computer reservation system to help provide patrons with an opportunity to use one of the public computers. Computers located in the Internet Express area on the first floor and in the Access Plus Room and 21st Century area on the second floor are on the new system.

If computers are available, patrons can go directly to a computer and log in. Log in requires entering a Cerritos Library card number and a PIN, or a Computer and Print Use card number and PIN. The default PIN is 111111. Patrons who would like to customize their PIN can ask the Computer Help Desk (InfoStation 3) staff for help. Patrons are also required to accept the Library's Public Computer Use and Internet Access Policy as part of the log in process.

If there are no computers available, patrons can enter a reservation request at a Computer Sign-Up station. The Computer Sign-Up Stations are available at the Internet Express area on the first floor and in the Print Center on the second floor. Screens in each area display a reservation queue that lists the first name and last initial of each person who has entered a reservation request. When a computer becomes available, the screen will show the location and number of the computer where the patron can log in.

Computers can only be reserved on the day of use. Reservations can only be made at the library.

The following time limits are in effect. The system automatically logs patrons off the computer after the time limit is reached.

There are three computers located on stands near the Adult Reference Desk that can be used for up to 15 minutes without a reservation.

For patrons who do not have a Cerritos Library card, registration for a free Computer and Print card is available at the Circulation Desk on the first floor and at the Computer Help Desk (InfoStation 3) on the second floor. To register for the card, patrons are required to present photo identification such as a driver's license; state ID card; school or university ID card; employer's ID card; or passport.

CERRITOS LIBRARY LAUNCHES HOOPLA

The Cerritos Library has launched a new digital media streaming service called hoopla, which allows patrons access to nearly half a million titles from six different categories: Movies, TV, Music Albums, eAudiobooks, eBooks and Comics/Graphic Novels. Enjoy the goods from your computer, tablet or Smartphone!

Cerritos Library cardholders are allowed up to six checkouts from hoopla per month. There is no limit to the number of cardholders who can simultaneously check out the same title. With this easy-to-use service, there are no hold lists and no extra apps or accounts are required to use it.

Audiobook, eBook and comic titles are lent for 21 days. Music titles are lent for 7 days. Movie and television titles are lent for 3 days.

On a mobile device, borrowed content may be temporarily downloaded and accessed offline. In either the app or on a computer, all borrowed content may also be enjoyed while connected to the internet by streaming.

To enjoy hoopla digital for free with your Cerritos Library card, download the hoopla digital app from your Apple or Google Play store on your mobile device. If you are using a desktop, visit hoopladigital.com.

Hoopla for kids is a multi-format, digital experience designed especially for kids and families. Hoopla for kids can be accessed through a Kids Mode setting in hoopla. To access Kids Mode through a mobile device, visit your hoopla settings and move the toggle to put hoopla into Kids Mode on your device. To access Kids Mode through a personal computer, go to hoopladigital.com and log in to your account. Then click on the "Settings" link in the upper right corner. On the Settings page, click the "On" button for Kids Mode.
